



Licence Agreement for the ETSI Documentation Service (EDS)

1 Parties

The parties to this Licence Agreement ("Agreement") are the Licensee, the purchaser of the ETSI Documentation Service (EDS), and the Licensor, the European Telecommunication Standards Institute ("ETSI"), hereinafter referred as "the Parties".

This Agreement provides the conditions of the use of the EDS and is generated by the Licensee Purchase Order, to the ETSI Publications Office or to an Approved distributor of the ETSI Documentation Service.

Acceptance of the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall take effect by the breaking of the seal on the EDS packaging.

2 Service

The EDS consists of:

- a) Compact or Digital Versatile Discs containing the full library of ETSI deliverables.
- b) ETSI Server access to the deliverables published since the last release of the EDS for a period of Ninety (90) days per EDS received.

3 Grant of Licence

The Compact Digital Versatile Discs and the ETSI deliverables, which are obtained through the EDS, are not sold but licensed in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement.

The use of the EDS shall be as follows:

- a) The EDS can be installed and used on networks owned and controlled by the Licensee or the Licensees wholly owned subsidiary.
- b) Each employee of the Licensees company is authorized to download or print the data or any portion thereof.
- c) The Licensee may not download or post any portion of the EDS into a publicly accessible network.
- d) The Licensee may not create derivative works based on the EDS or any portion thereof.
- e) The Licensee may not de-compile, reverse engineer, attempt to disassemble or reveal the proprietary, programming techniques or structure used in the software.
- f) The Licensee may not sell, sub-licence, rent, lease or distribute the EDS or any part of the information obtained through the EDS, other than as in b) above.

4 Compliance with Licence

The Licensee agrees that upon request from ETSI, or ETSI's authorized representative, the Licensee will within thirty (30) days fully document and certify that their use of the EDS at the time of the request is in conformity with this EDS Licence Agreement.



5 Copyright and proprietary protection

ETSI owns the copyright in its Deliverables and in the content of the EDS. This Agreement provides the terms and conditions under which you are licensed to use the EDS. It is not an agreement for the sale of the EDS content to you. The Licensee acquires no ownership rights to the EDS whatsoever, or any portion thereof.

While respecting the ETSI copyright, the EDS may be used by the Licensee to:

- a) further the work of ETSI or any standards body developing related standards;
- b) provide guidance for the Licensees product or service development and implementation;
- c) serve as a support for documentation associated with a product or service of the purchasing company.

6 Liability

Any dispute between the Parties concerning the implementation or the interpretation of this Agreement, which cannot be settled amicably between them through mutual negotiations, shall be finally settled by the Court of Justice of Grasse (Alpes Maritimes - France).

8 Term and termination

This Licence Agreement will become effective at the time of the breaking of the seal and will terminate upon the receipt of a new version of the EDS by the Licensee. The Licensee will either return or destroy the Compact discs at the termination of this Agreement.

9 Assignability

Licensee shall not assign this Agreement or any right hereunder, either in whole or in part, without the prior written consent of ETSI.

10 General

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Licensee and ETSI and supersedes any prior agreement concerning the contents or use of the EDS.
