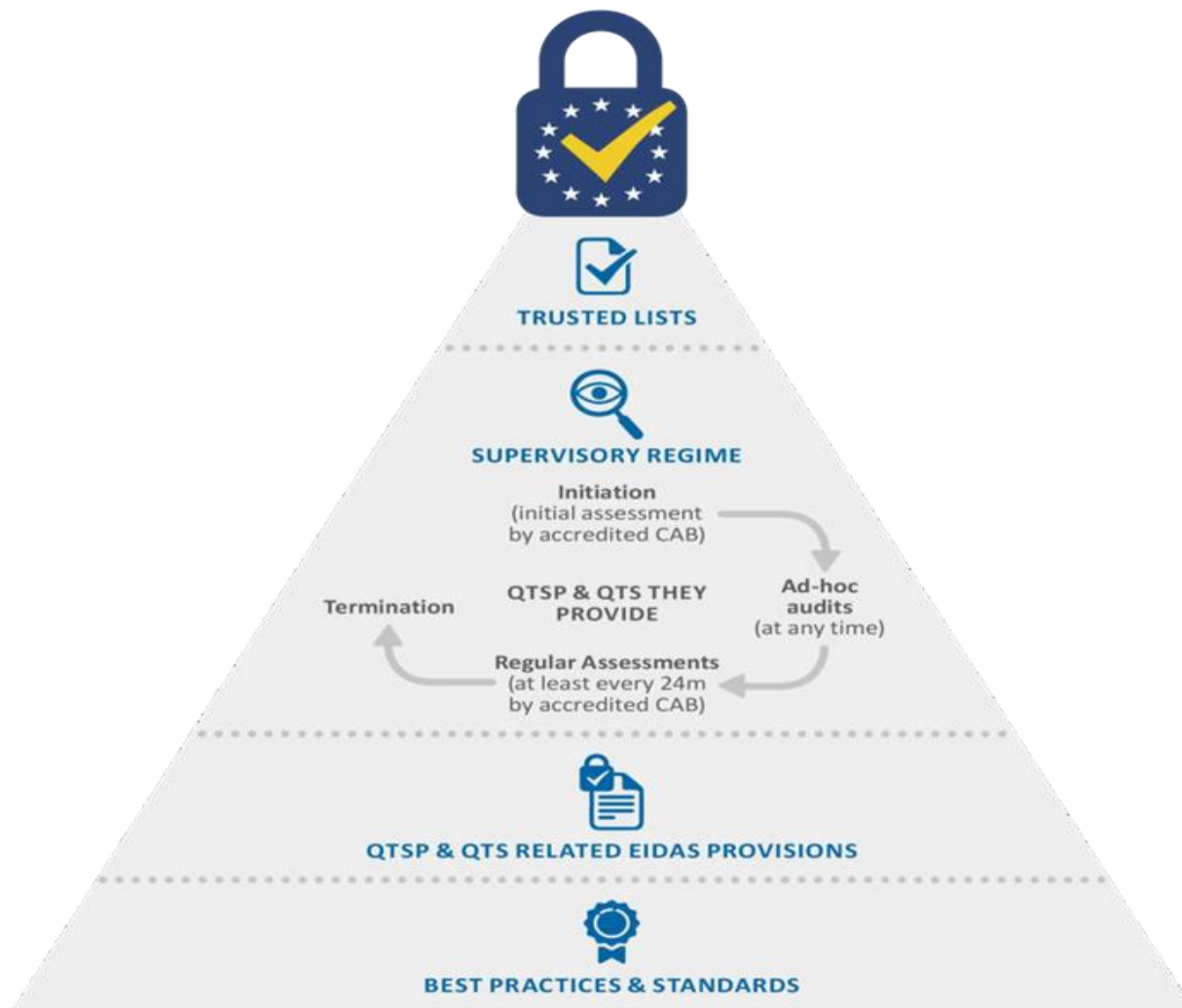

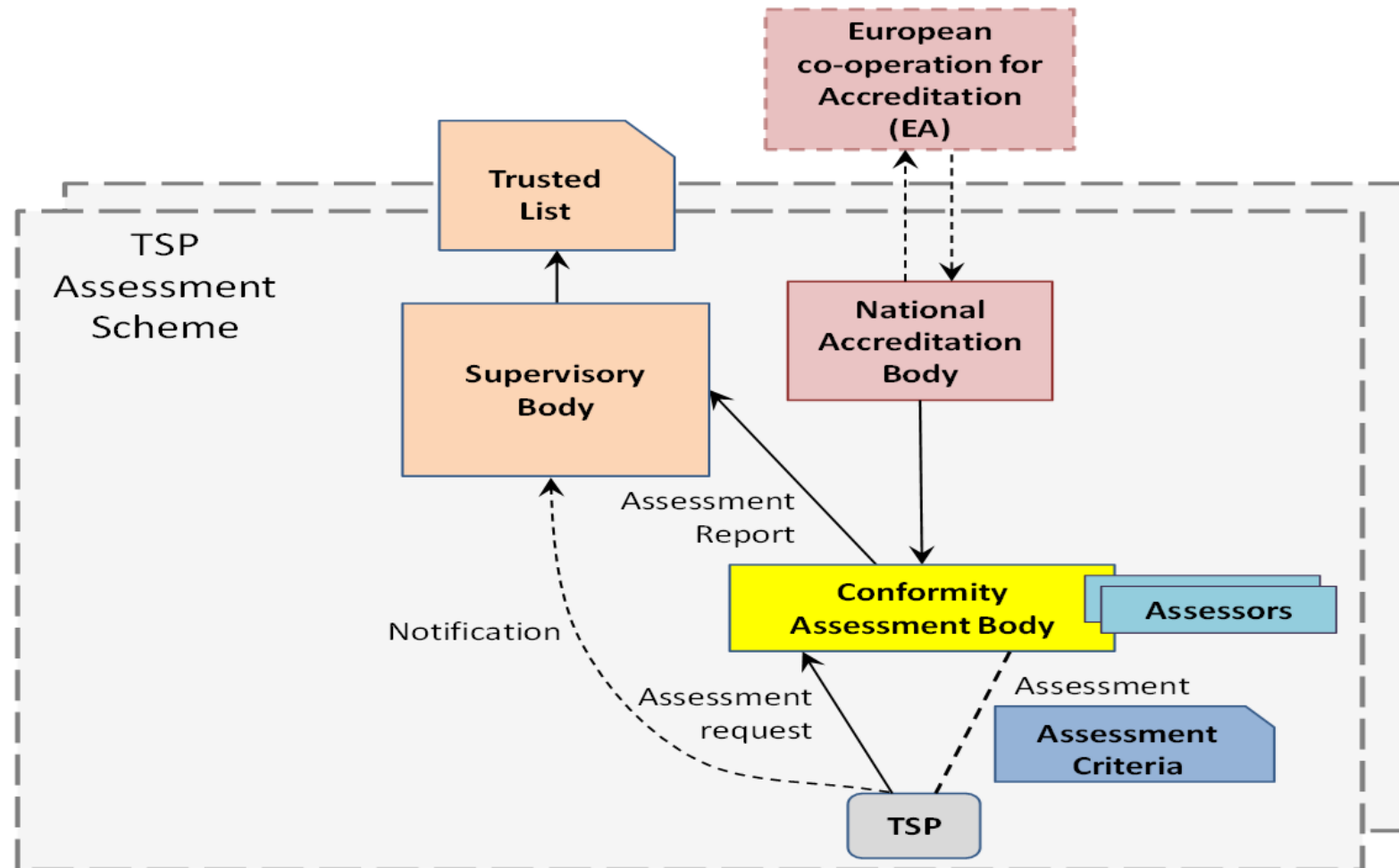

eIDAS Part III Audit and Supervision Framework



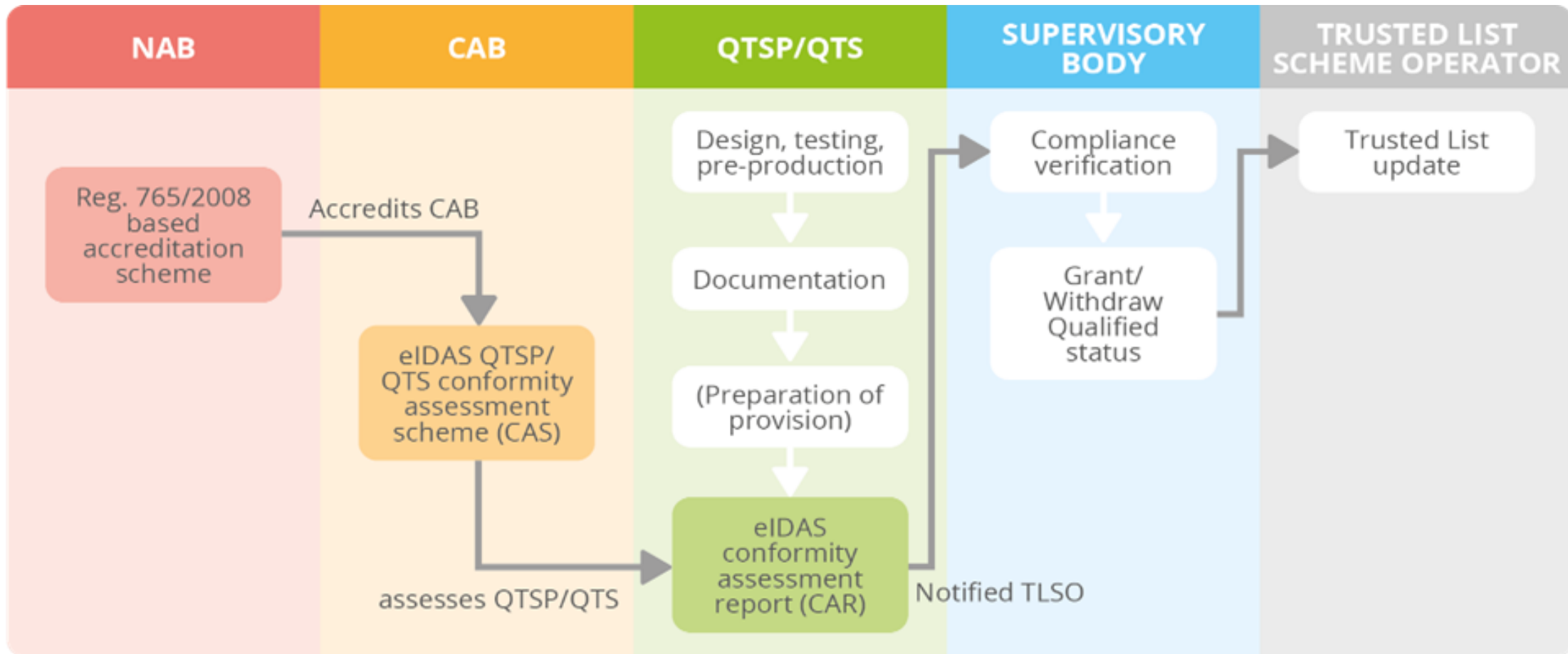

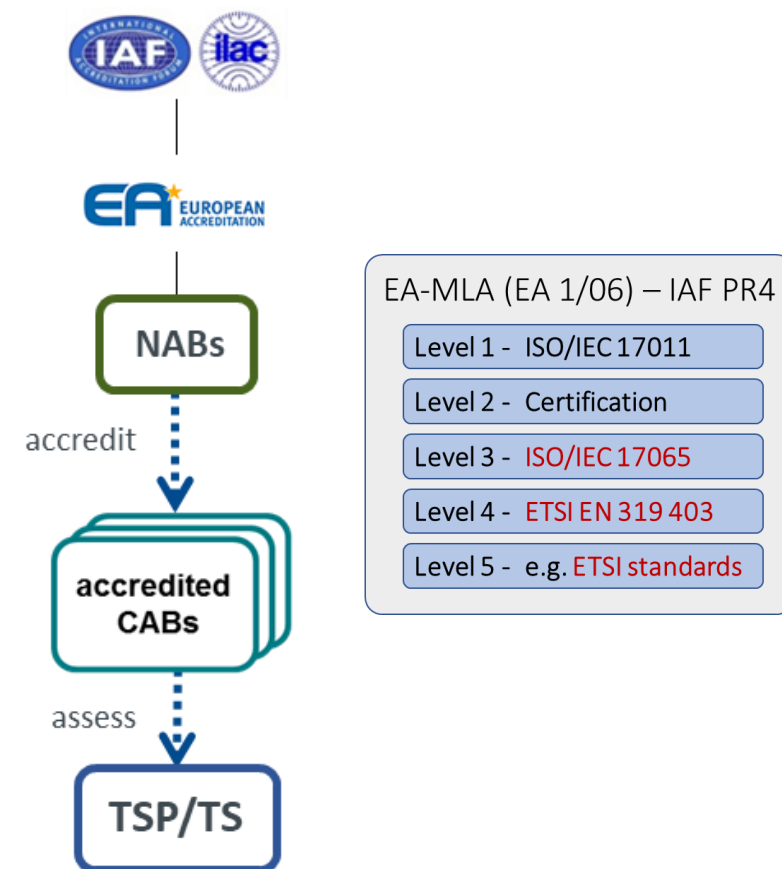
ETSI Best practise audit framework

EN 319 403-1 on requirements for bodies auditing TSPs

- Primary reference: **ISO/IEC 17065** specifying general requirements for conformity assessment bodies (CABs) performing certification of products, processes, or services
- Supplements ISO/IEC 17065 to provide additional dedicated requirements for CABs performing certification of TSPs
- Incorporates additional requirements on CABs relating to the audit of a TSP's management system, as defined in **ISO/IEC 17021** and in **ISO/IEC 27006**

New supplements on additional requirements for CABs auditing

- Part 2: TSPs issuing PTC (e.g. as in CA/Browser Forum)
- Part 3: QTSPs against eIDAS Regulation



Audits based on EN 319 403

- Audit report provided to supervisory body every 2 years
- Full audit required in case of major changes
- Meets the eIDAS requirement areas (esp. Art. 19, 24, 28)
- Follows best practices (e. g. ETSI standards 319 401 and 411)
- Communication with supervisory body

Audits based on EN 319 403

Document assessment (security concept / operations) – Stage 1

- all necessary technical, functional and organisational security measures and
- their appropriateness for fulfilment of eIDAS requirements

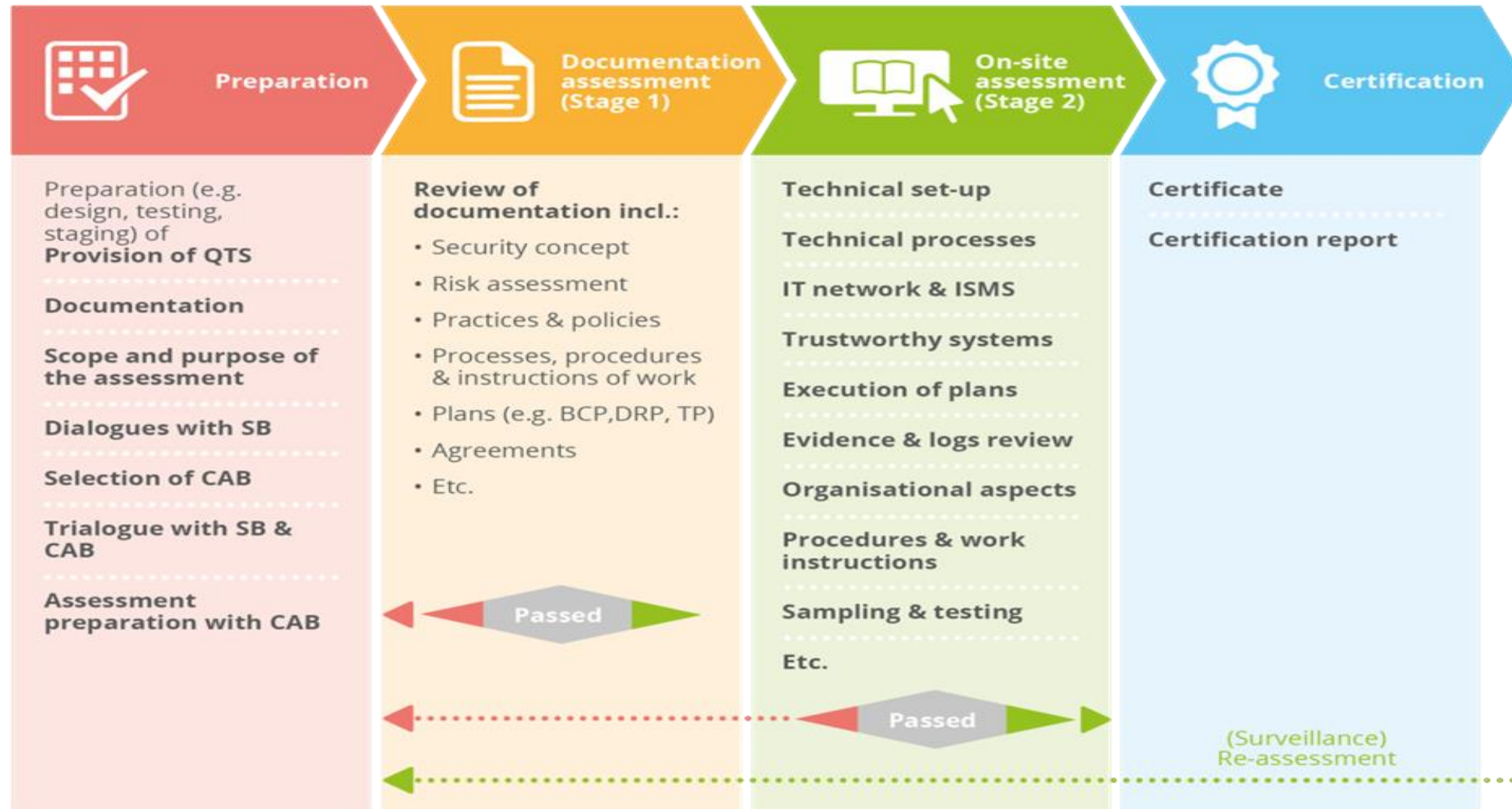
On-Site assessment – Stage 2

- verify the implementation of security measures,
- including technical and penetration testing

Results report

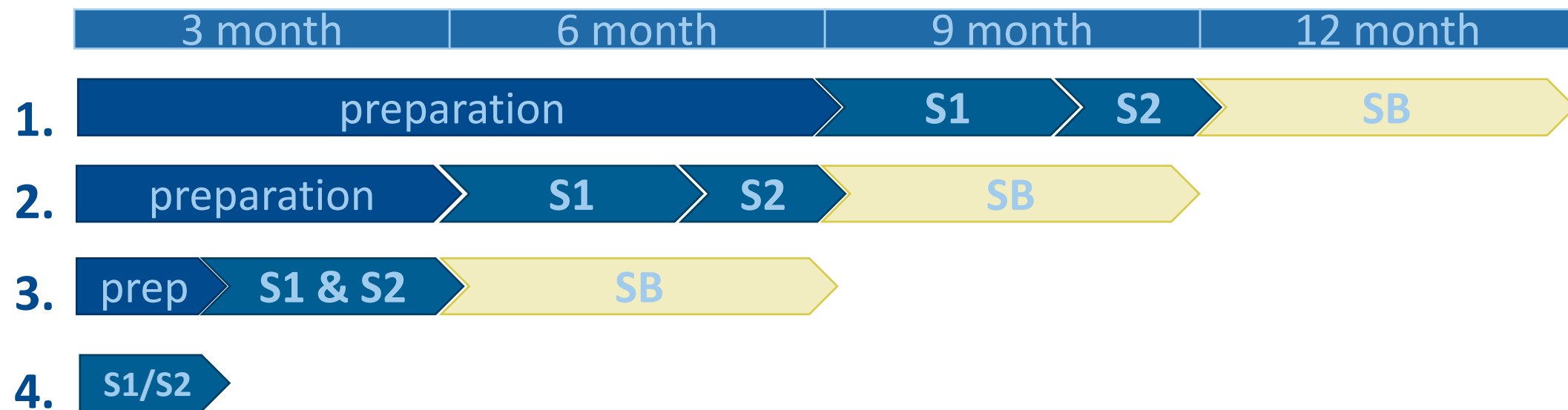
- scope: identification of the TSP, service and policy
- content and summary of conformity assessment activities
- additional content as required by supervisory authority

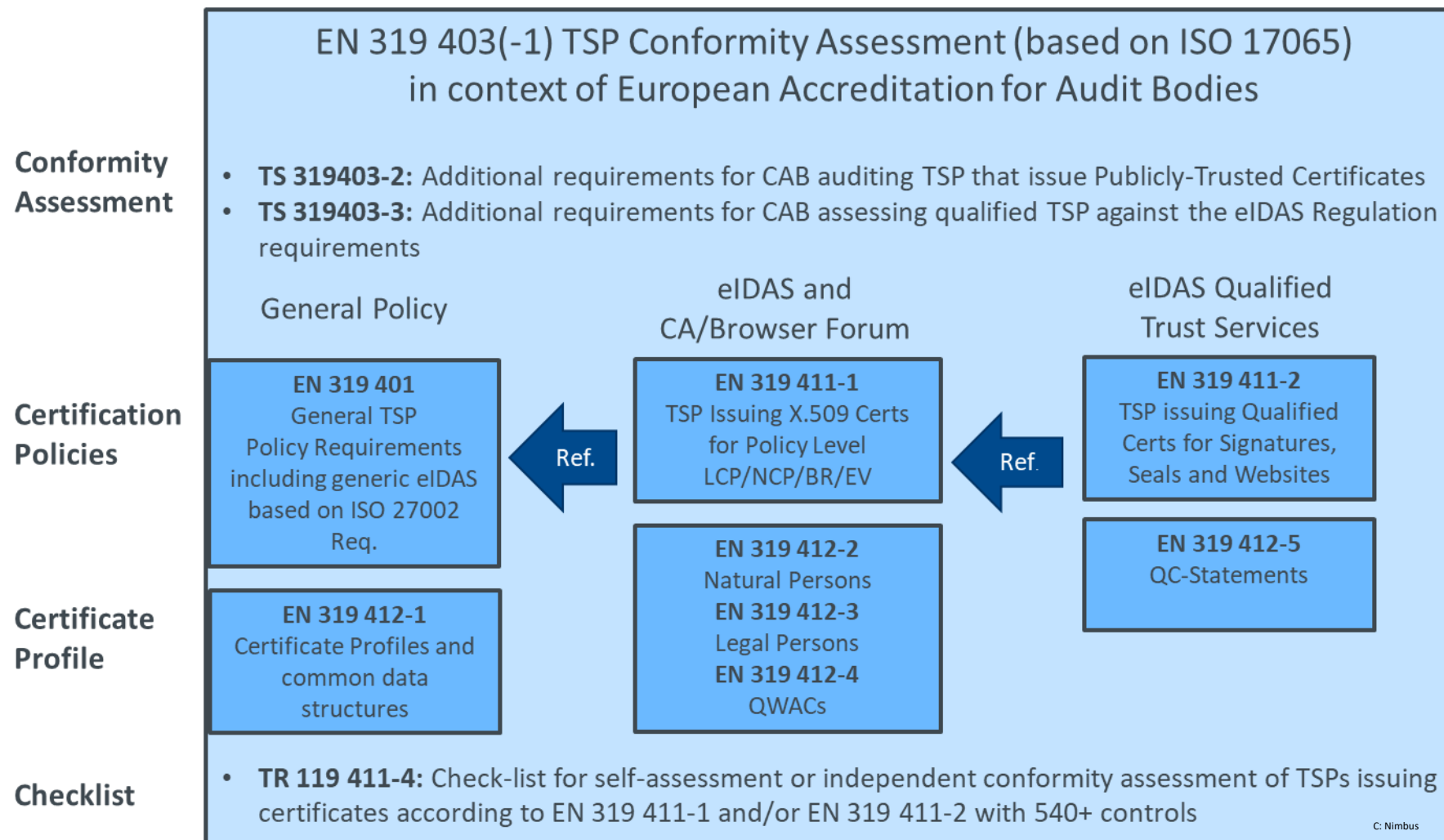
Timeline to become a TSP



- 1. new TSP normal case (~1 year)
- 2. new TSP very fast case (~9 month)
- 3. existing TSP normal case (~6 month)
- 4. re-assessment of Q-TSP (~1 month)
