

The series uses the Integrated Services Digital Network (ISDN) concepts as developed by ITU-T and conforms to the framework of standards for Open Systems Interconnection (OSI) as defined by ISO/IEC.

This particular EN specifies the Q interface Signalling protocol (QSIG) for use at the Q reference point in support of the Private User Mobility Registration Supplementary Service. The QSIG protocol is known as "Private integrated Signalling System no.1" (PSS1) in International Standards.
