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## Foreword

This second edition European Telecommunication Standard (ETS) has been produced by the Communication, Networks, and Systems Interconnection Technical Committee (TC32) of ECMA on behalf of its members and those of the European Telecommunications Standards Institute (ETSI).

This ETS is one of a series of standards defining services and signalling protocols applicable to Private Integrated Services Networks (PISN). The series uses the Integrated Services Digital Network (ISDN) concepts as developed by ITU-T and conforms to the framework of standards for Open Systems Interconnection (OSI) as defined by ISO/IEC.

This particular ETS specifies the Diversion supplementary services. The Diversion supplementary services are:

- Call Forwarding Unconditional (SS-CFU);
- Call Forwarding Busy (SS-CFB);
- Call Forwarding No Reply (SS-CFNR); and
- Call Deflection (SS-CD).

The previous (first) edition of this ETS contained a "standalone" specification of these supplementary services. This edition endorses an International Standard, ISO/IEC 13872, published since the publication of the first edition of this ETS.
