This draft European Telecommunication Standard (ETS) has been produced by the Signalling Protocols and Switching (SPS) Technical Committee of the European Telecommunications Standards Institute (ETSI), and is now submitted for the Public Enquiry phase of the ETSI standards approval procedure.

#### Scope

This thirty-third part of ETS 300 356 contains the conformance test specification for ISUP version 2 basic call control and signalling procedures as specified in ETS 300 356-1 [15]. It is applicable to all types of exchanges as defined in the reference specification.

This ETS presents the requirements regarding the test method and conventions used within the Abstract Test Suite (ATS), the partial Protocol Implementation eXtra Information for Testing (PIXIT) proforma, the Protocol Conformance Test Report proforma and the ATS written in Tree and Tabular Combined Notation (TTCN)<sup>2)</sup>.
