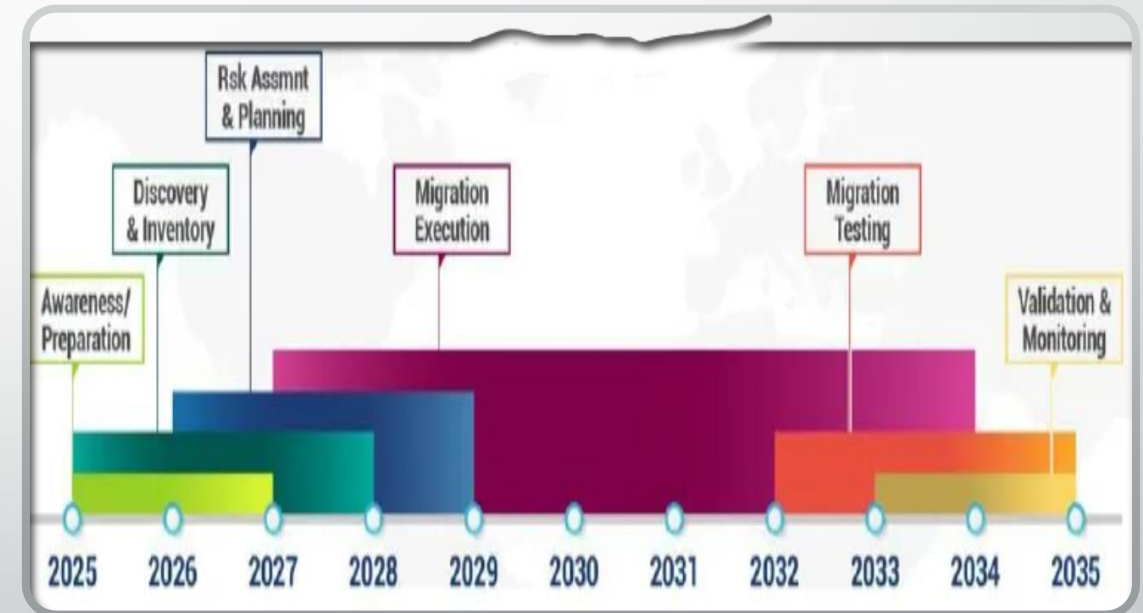

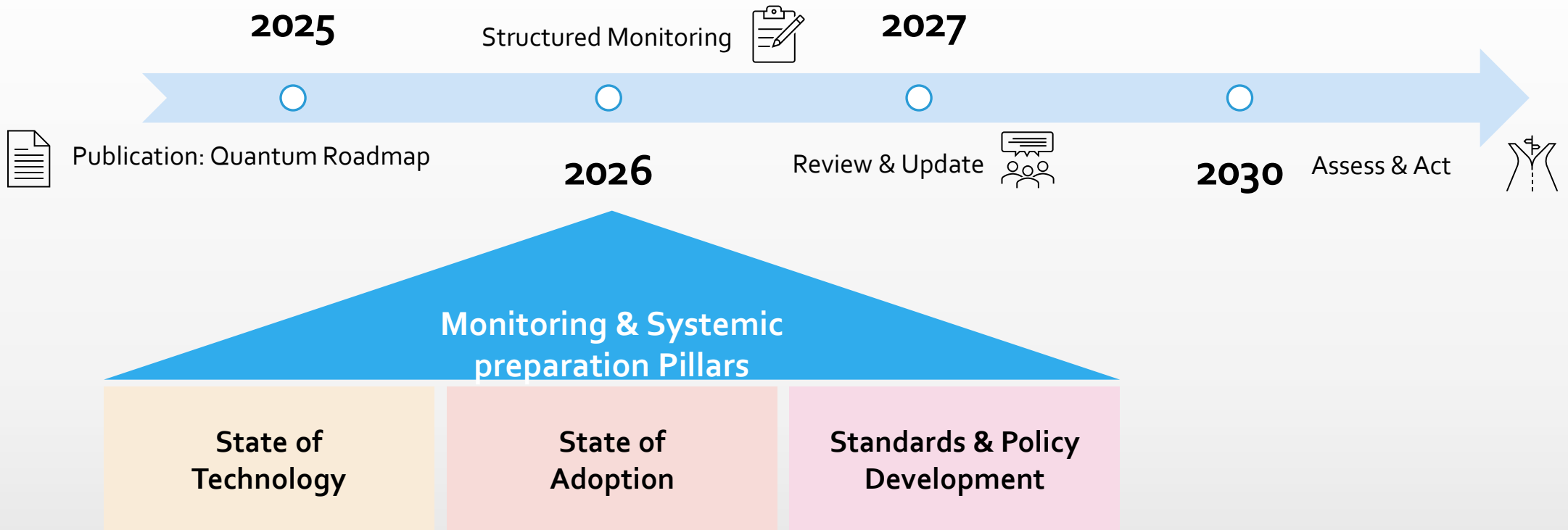
Quantum Resilience Roadmap for the Transition to Post-Quantum Cryptography in the Financial Sector

Published in **January 2026** the roadmap is:

- The first authoritative quantum policy statement in the financial sector;
- Provides a systemic importance and criticality driven timeline;
- Enables a flexible and pragmatic approach to implementation.



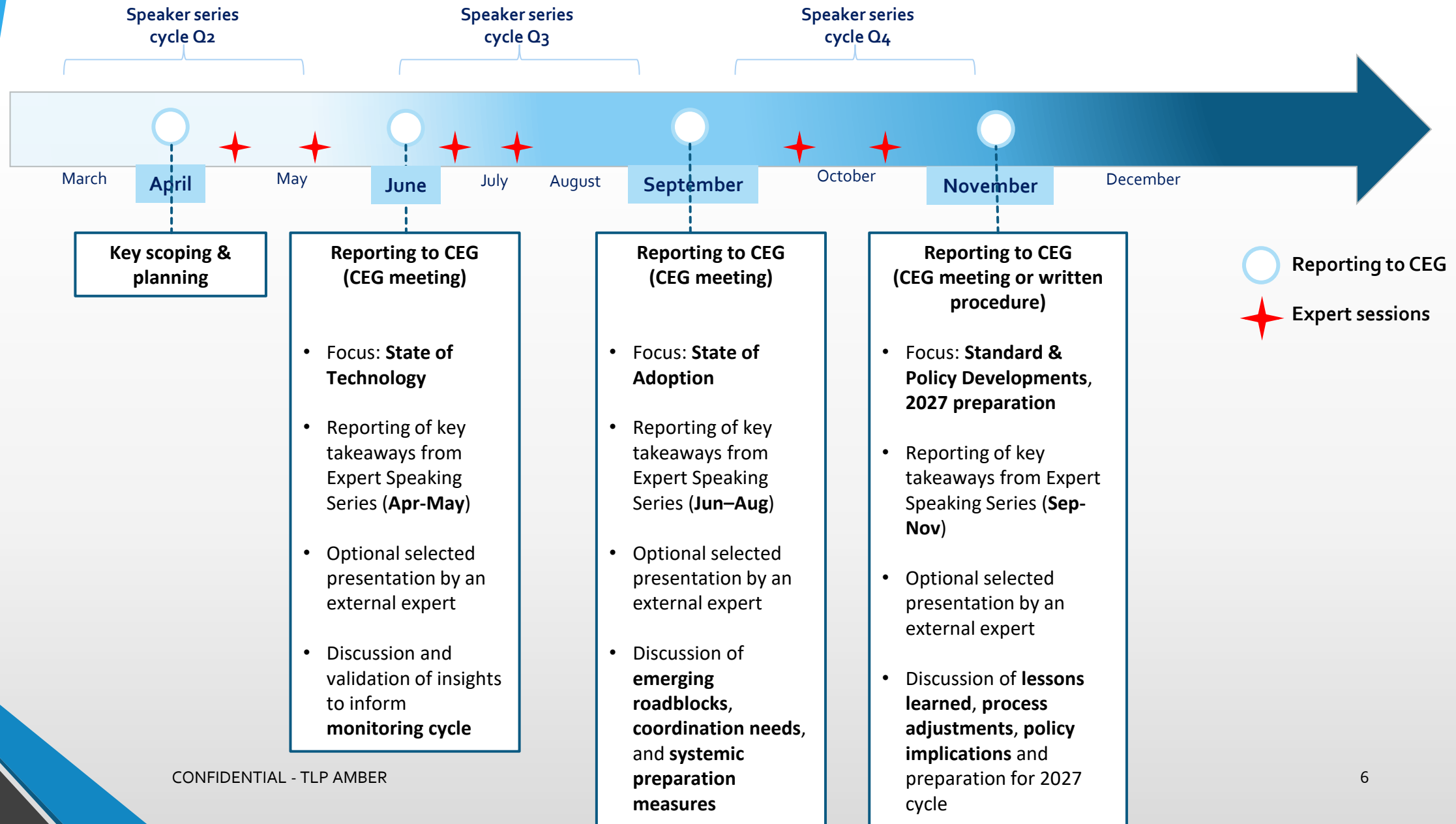
Strategic Monitoring Framework



Strategic Objectives

Pillars	Strategic objectives
Monitoring progress of the PQC migration	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Track the state of technology, adoption and standardisation relevant for financial sector migration○ Provide structured visibility on emerging developments affecting the migration roadmap○ Contribute to a multi-year monitoring cycle (2026–2030) supporting future roadmap updates
Supporting systemic preparation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Anticipate technical, operational and policy roadblocks that could affect migration○ Facilitate structured dialogue with key stakeholders (standard-setting bodies, cyber agencies, industry)○ Provide early analytical input to support the financial sector's transition to PQC
Translating insights into strategic guidance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Design support tools for monitoring and guidance (e.g., stock-take template)○ Extract key takeaways from expert discussions and monitoring activities○ Contribute to policy and coordination initiatives
