

# How to get to Carleton University

## OC Transpo Directions for Airport/Hotels:

### Transportation from the Ottawa/Macdonald–Cartier International Airport:

- From the Ottawa Airport, you can easily travel to Carleton University or the Ottawa Downtown neighbourhood (Les Suites or DoubleTree Ottawa Downtown Hotels) using OC Transpo's train system.
- From the Airport Station, take Line 4 (South Keys – Airport) toward South Keys Station for two stops (approximately seven minutes). Get off at South Keys Station.
- At South Keys Station, take Line 2 (Bayview – Limebank) North toward Bayview Station for four stops to Carleton University (approximately 13 minutes), or seven stops to Bayview Station (approximately 21 minutes) if you are continuing Downtown.
- If you are going Downtown, get off at Bayview Station, and take Line 1 (Tunney's Pasture – Blair) East toward Blair for four stops to Rideau Station (approximately eight minutes). Both Les Suites and DoubleTree Ottawa Downtown Hotels are an approximately four-minute walk from Rideau Station.

### Les Suites and DoubleTree Ottawa Downtown to Carleton:

- Les Suites is located at **130 Besserer St, Ottawa, ON K1N 9M9**.
- DoubleTree Ottawa Downtown is located at **33 Nicholas St, Ottawa, ON K1N 9M7**.
- From either Les Suites or DoubleTree Ottawa Downtown, walk to Rideau Station (approximately a four-minute walk).
- From Rideau Station, take Line 1 (Tunney's Pasture – Blair) West toward Tunney's Pasture for four stops (approximately eight minutes). Get off at Bayview Station.
- From Bayview Station, take Line 2 (Bayview – Limebank) South toward Limebank for three stops (approximately eight minutes). Get off at Carleton University.

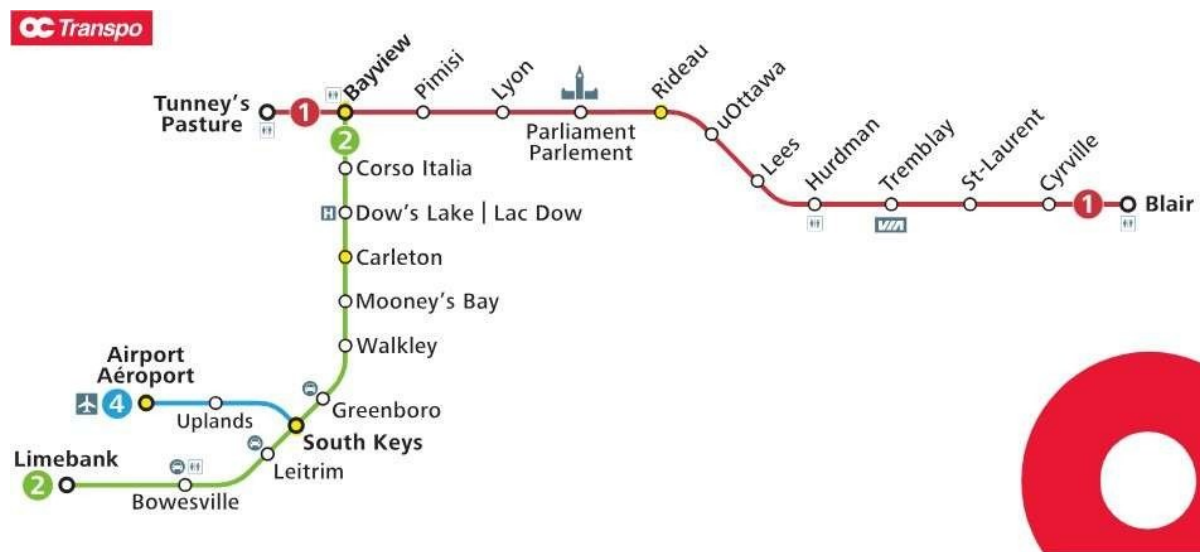
- Depending on the time of day, Line 1 arrives every 3-10 minutes. During rush hour, it runs more frequently.
- Line 2 and 4 run every 12 minutes.

**How to Pay:** To pay fare for any OC Transpo bus or train, you can tap your debit card, credit card or mobile wallet. If you are transferring between busses or trains, make sure you use the same payment method each time to ensure you are not double charged within the transfer window (90 minutes). If you are using OC Transpo multiple times throughout the day, your charge will be capped at the Day Pass price. More information can be found here:

## Getting to Richcraft Hall:

The 2026 ETSI/IQC Quantum Safe Cryptography Conference will be hosted in Richcraft Hall (formerly River Building) located on Carleton University's campus.

Carleton University's address is 1125 Colonel By Dr, Ottawa, ON K1S 5B6, however, this is not the exact location of Richcraft Hall.

Richcraft Hall is located at the corner of Campus Avenue and University Drive. Use this link to locate Richcraft Hall on Google Maps: <https://maps.app.goo.gl/U2mtaBGNQKR6WidF9>.

Richcraft hall is an approximately four-minute walk from the Carleton University Line 2 train station.

## Parking Instructions:

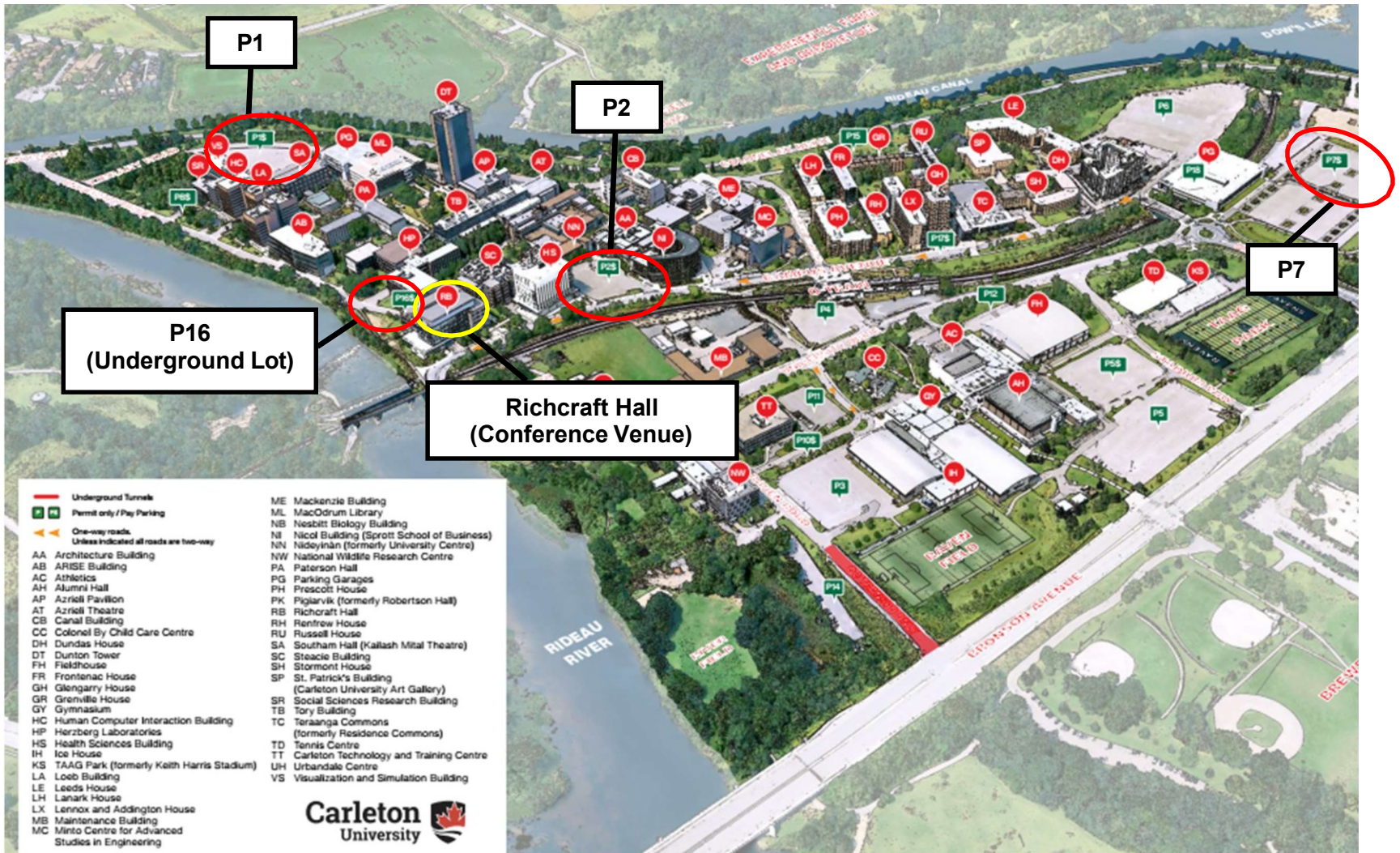

### Parking Code and Rate:

From 7 a.m. on June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026, to midnight on June 18<sup>th</sup>, 2026, all guests will have access to a discounted parking rate at all paid parking lots on campus.
